MOTION AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT FOR ORDER TO APPROVE
DISTRIBUTION OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS TO CLASS MEMBERS AND PAYMENT
OF ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND EXPENSES FOR THE DIRECT PURCHASER
SETTLEMENT CLASSES

RELIMINARY STATEMENT

The Direct Purchaser Class ("Plaintiffs" or the "Class") respectfully requests that this Court enter the [Proposed] Order to Approve: (1) direct distribution of the Net Settlement Funds to Settlement Class Members in connection with the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Hickory Springs Manufacturing Company (the "Hickory Springs Settlement Agreement") and the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendants Woodbridge Foam Corporation, Woodbridge Sales & Engineering, Inc., and Woodbridge Foam Fabricating, Inc. (the "Woodbridge Settlement Agreement"); (3) approve of GCG's fees and expenses of \$ 175,754.71, invoiced since the last motion seeking approval of notice fees (Dkt. 1868), as set forth in Ex. A to the Declaration of Jacqueline Brasefield ("Brasefield Declaration").

ARGUMENT

On May 16, 2016, this Court approved the administrative determinations of the Claims Administrator Garden City Group, LLC ("GCG") as to whether to accept or reject the claims submitted by the Class (including acceptance of various late Claim Forms), and resolution of all disputed and adjusted claim amounts in connection with all settlements in this case. (Dkt. 2095).

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¹ In addition to the Hickory Springs Settlement and the Woodbridge Settlement, the settlements include the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class Plaintiffs and Defendant Leggett & Platt, Incorporated (the "L&P Settlement Agreement"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendants Carpenter Co., E.R. Carpenter, L.P., and Carpenter Holdings, Inc. (the "Carpenter Settlement Agreement"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant FFP Holdings, LLC (f/k/a Flexible Foam Products, Inc.) (the "FFP Settlement Agreement); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Future Foam, Inc. (the "Future Foam Settlement Agreement"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Foamex Innovations, Inc. (the "FXI Settlement Agreement"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Mohawk Industries, Inc. (the "Mohawk Settlement Agreement"); and the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendants Vitafoam, Inc. and Vitafoam Products Canada Limited ("Vitafoam Agreement").

This Court also approved direct distribution of Net Settlement Funds to Settlement Class Members of the Settlement Funds that had been paid through the date of the Class's May 9, 2016 Motion to Approve Distribution of Settlement Funds to Class Members and Payment of Notice Fees for the Direct Purchaser Settlement Classes ("First Distribution Motion") (Dkt. 2086), as well as GCG's fees and expenses that had been incurred through that same period. (Dkt. 2095). The amounts available as Net Settlement Funds were calculated by subtracting attorneys' fees, administrative fees and expenses incurred through that same period, and also future anticipated administrative fees and expenses. *E.g.* Dkt. 2086-2 (Castaneda Declaration at ¶36(a), 55(a)).

The Hickory Springs and Woodbridge Settlements provided for staggered payments over time. Specifically, the Hickory Springs Settlement provided for Hickory Springs to pay \$19,500,000, total, on the following schedule: \$3,000,000 around the time the Settlement Agreement was signed; \$2,500,000 within 10 days of Final Approval of the Settlement Agreement; \$7,000,000 on or before January 31, 2016; and \$7,000,000 on or before January 31, 2017. The Woodbridge Settlement provided that Woodbridge would pay \$50,000,000, total, on the following schedule: \$9,000,000 around the time of the settlement agreement; \$9,000,000 on or before November 15, 2015; \$14,000,000 on or before November 15, 2017. Dkt. 1699-1 at 3-4.

Accordingly, since this Court's May 16, 2016 approval of the distribution of the Net Settlement Funds pursuant to the First Distribution Motion, Hickory Springs and Woodbridge have respectively paid the \$7,000,000 and \$14,000,000 that were owed to date pursuant to the terms of their settlements. After accounting for attorneys' fees, \$5,600,160.03 is available for distribution to class members from the Hickory Springs Settlement and \$11,200,442.57 is available for distribution to class members from the Woodbridge Settlement. Brasefield Decl. ¶

7. The Class seeks approval to distribute these funds to Class Members as set forth in Exhibit B to the Brasefield Declaration.

Moreover, since this Court's May 16, 2016 Order, the claims administrator has incurred costs associated with administering all settlements in this litigation (see *supra* n.1). The Class and claims administrator anticipated that such costs would be incurred and, prior to the Spring 2016 distributions, set aside a portion of all settlements to address such costs, as noted above and as set forth in Lori Castaneda's May 2016 Declaration, which was attached to the Class' First Distribution Motion. Dkt. 2086-2 at ¶¶36(a), 55(a). Consistent with these anticipated future fees and expenses, GCG has incurred additional administrative fees and expenses through the date of this Motion in the amount of \$ 175,754.71 Brasefield Decl. ¶ 5, Ex. A. The amounts set aside prior to the Spring 2016 distributions are more than sufficient to reimburse the claims administrator for these administrative fees and expenses.

Accordingly, the Class seeks permission to approve distribution of Settlement Funds for payment of administrative costs and fees in the *pro rata* amounts of \$12,314.45 from the Leggett & Platt settlement fund; \$33,413.16 from the Carpenter settlement fund; \$28,319.90 from the FXI settlement fund; \$9,205.92 from the Hickory Springs settlement fund; \$46,250.64 from the Mohawk settlement fund; \$7,554.57 from the FFP settlement fund; \$15,096.15 from the Future Foam settlement fund; and \$23,599.92 from the Woodbridge settlement fund.

CONCLUSION

For all the reasons set forth above, the Class respectfully requests that the Court approve Plaintiffs' request for direct distribution of the Net Settlement Funds and approve Plaintiffs' request for payments to the Claims Administrator for fees incurred to date.

DECLARATION OF JACQUELINE BRASEFIELD REGARDING ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND SECOND DISTRIBUTION TO ELIGIBLE CLASS MEMBERS

I, JACQUELINE BRASEFIELD, declare as follows:

- 1. I am an Assistant Director, Operations at Garden City Group, LLC ("GCG"). The following statements are based on my personal knowledge and information provided by other experienced GCG employees working under my supervision, and, if called on to do so, I could and would testify competently thereto.
- 2. GCG is serving as the Claims Administrator in the above-captioned litigation ("Action") in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class Plaintiffs and Defendant Leggett & Platt, Incorporated ("Leggett & Platt"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendants Carpenter Co., E.R. Carpenter, L.P., and Carpenter Holdings, Inc. ("Carpenter"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant FFP Holdings, LLC (f/k/a Flexible Foam Products, Inc.) ("FFP"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Future Foam, Inc. ("Future Foam"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Foamex Innovations, Inc. ("FXI"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Hickory Springs Manufacturing Company ("Hickory Springs"); the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendant Mohawk Industries, Inc.

("Mohawk"); and the Settlement Agreement Between Direct Purchaser Class and Defendants Woodbridge Foam Corporation, Woodbridge Sales & Engineering, Inc., and Woodbridge Foam Fabricating, Inc. ("Woodbridge").

- 3. GCG has completed the processing of all submitted claim forms related to the above referenced Settlements and issued the eligible Class Member payments in June 2016 relating to the funds received into the Settlement Accounts for Vitafoam, Carpenter, Leggett & Platt, FFP, FXI, Future Foam, Hickory Springs, Mohawk, and Woodbridge prior to June 2016. GCG submits this declaration to provide details regarding the incurred administrative fees and expenses relating to the administration of the Carpenter, Leggett & Platt, FFP, FXI, Future Foam, Hickory Springs, Mohawk, and Woodbridge Settlements. Additionally, GCG submits this declaration to provide details regarding the upcoming distribution of funds received into the Hickory Springs Qualified Settlement Fund and the Woodbridge Qualified Settlement Fund.
- 4. Previously, as noted in the Direct Purchaser Class' May 9, 2016 Motion to Approve Distribution of Settlement Funds to Class Members and Payment of Notice Fees for the Direct Purchaser Settlement Classes (Dkt. 2086), GCG anticipated that a total estimated \$269,789.74 would be incurred in future administrative fees and expenses (Declaration of Lori L. Castaneda Regarding Settlement Administration, Dkt. 2086-2, at ¶35, 53). Prior to the June 2016 distribution, the \$269,789.74 in anticipated funds were held back to cover any fees and expenses incurred by GCG in its administration of the above-referenced Settlements.
- 5. The Court's May 16, 2016 Order (Dkt. 2095) approved payment of incurred administration fees and expenses from the Carpenter, Leggett & Platt, FFP, FXI, Future Foam,

Hickory Springs, Mohawk, and Woodbridge Qualified Settlement Funds.¹ Between the dates of March 1, 2016 and January 31, 2017, GCG has since incurred an additional \$175,754.71 in fees and expenses:

- a. \$33,413.16 related to the administration of the Carpenter Settlement;
- b. \$12,314.45 related to the administration of the Leggett & Platt Settlement;
- c. \$7,554.57 related to the administration of the FFP Settlement;
- d. \$28,319.90 related to the administration of the FXI Settlement;
- e. \$15,096.15 related to the administration of the Future Foam Settlement;
- f. \$9,205.92 related to the administration of the Hickory Springs Settlement;
- g. \$46,250.64 related to the administration of the Mohawk Settlement; and
- h. \$23,599.92 related to the administration of the Woodbridge Settlement.

These incurred fees and expenses are a result of the distribution of funds made in June 2016, Class Member inquiries, check reissue requests, and various Settlements' account maintenance. GCG's outstanding invoices are attached hereto as Exhibit A.

- 6. Between November 2016 and January 2017, the Qualified Settlement Funds for Hickory Springs and Woodbridge have received additional funds in the following manner:
 - a. On or about November 15, 2016, \$14 million was received into the Woodbridge
 Qualified Settlement Fund; and
 - b. On or about January 31, 2017, \$7 million was received into the Hickory Springs
 Qualified Settlement Fund.
- 7. GCG has received a total of \$21 million into the Woodbridge and Hickory Springs Settlement Accounts from November 2016 through January 2017. GCG has since distributed

¹ Previously supplied administrative fees and expenses related to the Carpenter, Leggett & Platt, FFP, FXI, Future Foam, Hickory Springs, Mohawk, and Woodbridge Settlements were incurred between the dates of December 1, 2015 and February 29, 2016.

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\$1.4 million of the Hickory Springs Settlement funds and \$2.8 million of the Woodbridge Settlement Funds, representing the 20 percent fee award granted by the Court in its Memorandum Opinion and Order re Settlement Motion (Dkt. 1971). After deduction of administrative fees and costs and attorneys' fees, GCG anticipates that \$5,600,160.03 is available for distribution to eligible Class Members from the Hickory Springs Qualified Settlement Fund and \$11,200,442.57 is available for distribution to eligible Class Members from the Woodbridge Qualified Settlement Fund.² A distribution chart of the estimated *pro rata* monetary awards available for each eligible Class Member from the Hickory Springs and Woodbridge Settlements is attached hereto as Exhibit B.³

 On approval of the court, GCG will distribute available funds from the Hickory Springs and Woodbridge Settlements to eligible Class Members.

³ Eligible Class Member's estimated award amounts were determined by (1) dividing the Hickory Springs and Woodbridge Settlement Funds by the total dollar amount of valid claimed purchases of Flexible Polyurethane Foam from participating Class Members during the Class Period, then (2) multiplying the resulting fraction by the amount of each participating Class Member's eligible valid claimed purchases of Flexible Polyurethane Foam.
